## What information do I need to complete the FAFSA?

- 2021 income tax returns for students and parents
- 2021 W-2 forms for students and parents
- Bank statements for students and parents
- Asset statements for students and parents (more information [here](#))
- FSA ID (see below for more information)
- Marital status of parents; if applicable, date of separation (more information [here](#))

## What is a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID?

## Who needs to create an FSA ID?

Students and one parent

## When do I need to use my FSA ID?

When logging in to any U.S. Department of Education website, like [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov), [StudentLoans.gov](https://studentloans.gov), and [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov).

## What information do I need to create an FSA ID?

- Full legal name
- Email address (if you do not have an email address, you will need to create one)
- Date of birth
- Social Security number
- Contact information (current home address)
- If applicable: old FAFSA PIN
