

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students:

As we approach the end of this school year, we wish to thank you for your support, patience, and understanding during this challenging year. With families and the school working together, we have been able to continue educating our AMS students in meaningful, effective, and impactful ways—both in-person and virtually.

Wednesday, June 2 will be our last day for this school year, followed by teacher In-Service Day on June 3. Please note the following items below that relate to the ending of the school year.

UNIT TESTS / FINAL EXAMINATIONS:

- **6th Graders** will have their Unit Tests on June 1 (B Block Day) and June 2 (A Block Day). Unit Test grades will be factored into the Fourth Quarter Grades.
- **7th and 8th Graders** will take their Final Examinations on June 1 (B Block Day) and June 2 (A Block Day), with the exam grade being factored into the Final Grade (refer to Student Handbook, page 38).
- Unit Tests (Grade 6) and Final Examinations (Grades 7/8) that are missed and/or not taken will automatically be calculated as an F grade.

ATTENDANCE: It is important that all students attend each school day within the district's attendance guidelines. Virtual learners (Track B) are expected to be logging into their classes each class period. In-person learners (Track A) are expected to attend school in person for the remainder of this school year, especially for Unit Tests or Final Examinations. If you have any questions, please call the Main Office.

DROP-OFF / PICK-UP: At arrival and dismissal times, we are asking that drivers continue to use the driveway by the sidewalk along the south side of the gymnasium and south parking lot (dismissal time only) for the safety of our pedestrians and bicycle riders.

TEXTBOOKS: Students can turn in their school textbooks and materials to their respective teachers as they move through the last two days of school. If you have any questions, please contact your child's teacher(s). Virtual learners can drop off their materials on Wednesday, June 2 (4:00-6:00 p.m.) in the lobby. Please remember to enter the main (flagpole) entrance while following health and safety guidelines.

CHROMEBOOKS / CHARGER CORDS (school-owned):

- In-person learners (Track A) will turn in their school-owned Chromebooks with charger cords to their 9th period teachers or study hall monitor on the last day of school – Wednesday, June 2 (Block A Day). Staff members will then record the submitted items for inventory.
- Virtual learners (Track B) will return their school-owned Chromebooks with charger cords on Wednesday, June 2 between 4:00-6:00 p.m. in the lobby. Please remember to enter the main (flagpole) entrance while following health and safety guidelines.

- Families will be charged for school-owned Chromebooks and charging cords not returned at the end of this school year.

YEARBOOKS: The pandemic has had an impact in the development of our typical yearbook production. This summer we will be sending out an email regarding when pre-ordered yearbooks will be available for pick up.

SCHOOL FEES: You can access your school fees balance through PowerSchool. School fees can be paid with a check written out to Avon BOE or paid online by going to <https://payschoolscentral.com/>. PaySchools can also be accessed from the Avon Local Schools website, www.avonlocalschools.org. Just scroll down to the bottom left and click on “Make a Payment.”

SCHOOL SUPPLIES: The AMS Boosters have partnered with 1st Day School Supplies again to offer parents one-stop shopping for all their school supply needs. These kits will contain exactly what is on the school supply list and will be shipped right to your front door in August. Remember to purchase the kit for the grade your child will be in next year, not their current grade! The deadline to order is July 1, 2021.
