FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE 2020-21

To avoid overload in the core academic classes (Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, World Language, and Mathematics), the Final Examination (Grades 7/8) and Unit Test (Grade 6) schedules are listed below. Most non-core courses will be having a graded activity on these assessment days. Attendance is mandatory for all classes and study halls. In-person learners (Track A) are to attend school in person, while virtual learners (Track B) are to log in to all their scheduled classes. See the *Student Handbook* under ACADEMICS to review how final examination grades (7/8) are calculated for the final grade in courses.

Final Unit Tests (Grade 6) and Final Examinations (Grades 7/8) for in-person learners (Track A) will be taken at school, in-person, and at the designated scheduled times.

Textbooks and school-owned Chromebooks (with chargers) are to be turned in as follows:

- In-person learners (Track A) will turn in their materials in the teachers during 9th period on Wednesday, June 2.
- Virtual learners (Track B) will return their materials to the school lobby on Wednesday, June 2 from 4:00-6:00 p.m.
- Fees for damaged or lost materials and devices will be assessed accordingly to the responsible student(s).

Early dismissals will only be permitted for bona fide, excusable reasons with parents sending a note to school with their student and then picking up their students for necessary appointments.

Make-up examinations / tests for **excused absences** will have to be arranged through the classroom teacher via the student's initiation. Unit Tests (Grade 6) and Final Examinations (Grades 7/8) that are missed and / or not taken will automatically be calculated as an F grade.

Bring a book or eReader to read at your test / examination, in the event you finish your assessment early.

Students are strongly encouraged to study and prepare well for their year-end assessments!

- Grade 6: Unit Test grades will affect your overall fourth quarter grades.
- Grades 7/8: Final Examination grades are transferred on the Report Card and affect Final Grades, which may affect if you pass the course (see *Student Handbook* for final grade calculation).
