- Continue to explore **Road Trip Nation**
- Attend a College Fair
 - At BW in October
 - At AHS during the school day in October
 - At LCCC in October
- Attend College Panel presentation at AHS
- Take the PSAT in October
- Meet with College Reps who visit AHS
- Attend AHS Financial Aid night
- Estimate your financial aid using FAFSA4caster.ed.gov
- Register for free test prep with Khan Academy using your PSAT results
- Plan to visit at least two colleges in the spring
- Create online accounts with ACT & Collegeboard (AP, PSAT & SAT)
- Register for the ACT or SAT once you have completed the majority of Algebra II and Chemistry courses (ACT.org or Collegeboard.org)
- Review the Scholarships listed in **Naviance** to determine deadlines and requirements in preparation for senior year
- Use the **Naviance College Search** on the Colleges tab to find Colleges offering majors in areas of interest
