- Schedule coursework appropriately challenging student
- Complete **Naviance Career Cluster Finder** - following a classroom session with School Counselor
- Continue adding info to **Student Bio/Resume**
  - Volunteer hours
  - Include awards
- Review list of recommended high school courses for the career and identify those offered at AHS
- Attend **Naviance Open Lab** times offered by School Counselors
- Participate in October Test Day (**Pre-ACT/ACCUPLACER** assessment)
- Discuss **Pre-ACT/ACCUPLACER** data with parents/guardians
- Attend College Panel Night at AHS
- Attend LCCC College Fair
- Attend College Credit Plus (CCP) Meeting to investigate dual enrollment options (parents & students)
- Attend **Naviance Nights** hosted by AHS Counselors (parents & students)
- Use the Careers Tab to explore one career identified in the Strengths Explorer/ Career Cluster Finder
- Add interesting careers identified on **Naviance Careers Tab**
- Begin adding colleges to the **Naviance “Colleges I’m Thinking About”** tab that offer degrees associated with majors. Should have one or two schools of interest at the end of 10<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Use **Naviance Road Trip Nation** to get information about careers
