

College Athletic Eligibility Timeline

What you need to do to play at the next level

Grade 9

- Ask your counselor for a list of your high school's [NCAA core courses](#) to make sure you take the right classes. (These are listed in the Program of Studies. Electronic copy available at avonlocalschools.org->High School->Guidance)

Grade 10

- Register with the NCAA Eligibility Center at eligibilitycenter.org.

Grade 11

- Check with your counselor to make sure you will graduate on time with the required number of [NCAA core courses](#). You must complete 10 core courses before 7th semester of high school (before senior year). Seven of those courses must be in math, English or science.
- Take the [ACT or SAT](#) and submit your scores to the NCAA using code 9999.
- At the end of the year, ask your counselor to upload your official transcript to the NCAA Eligibility Center.

Grade 12

- Finish your last [NCAA core courses](#). You must complete 16 core courses before you graduate.
- Complete all academic and [amateurism](#) questions in your NCAA Eligibility Center account at eligibilitycenter.org.
- After you graduate, ask your counselor to submit your final official transcript with proof of graduation to the NCAA Eligibility Center.
